## 1. STATE-WISE ALLOCATION OF SEATS:

a. State wise allocation for the admission into First year of Six Semesters (3 years) DHTT Course:

b. State wise allocation of seats for the direct admission into 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester (Second year) of Six Semesters DHTT Course through lateral entry.

The admission into Third Semester (Second year) through Lateral Entry has been earmarked to 10% of the intake capacity (i.e. 55 seats) of the Institute. Each State is entitled to get 10% of seats on the existing allocated quota in 1<sup>st</sup> year. In addition, the Lateral Entry admission will also be considered for the seats fallen vacant during the previous academic year 2022-2023 due to discontinuance of the candidates.

## 2. RESERVATION:

- 20% of the total seats allocated to a State are reserved for candidates belonging to Weavers' Community (Profession). Shortfall will be met out from the candidates other than Weavers' Community (Profession).
- 10% of the total seats allocated to a State are reserved for candidates belonging to Economically Weaker Section (EWS).
- So far as reservation of seats for admission of SC/ST/OBC/MOBC candidate is concerned, the respective State Directorates will follow the prevailing reservation policy of their states.
- Aggregate of marks obtained in SSC (10<sup>th</sup> standard) or equivalent qualifying examination shall be the basis for determining the merit of a candidate.
- The panel of the selected candidates is required to be prepared on merit basis and as per prevailing reservation policy of the concerned State Government for SC/ST/OBC/MOBC candidates.
- While preparing the merit list, in the event of two candidates scoring identical marks in aggregate, the candidates who had scored more marks in the subjects of Science and Mathematics taken together will stand higher in the merit.
